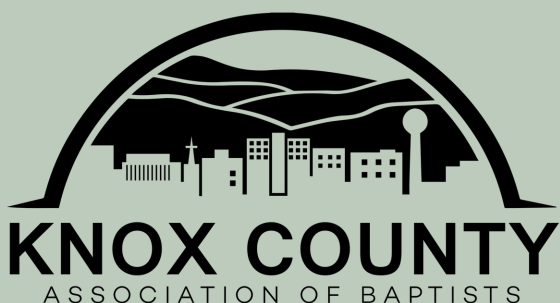

#### ENGAGE 10/10:

- Engage 10 priority Pockets of Lostness
- Engage 10 priority International People Groups in Knox County

Through *Nations and Neighbors* ministry, we seek to engage the Nations and our Neighbors here in Knox County with the love of Christ. Studies tell us we have 38,000+ internationals from 120+ countries living in Knox county; and we have 80% or 350,000+ people living in Knox County that have no relationship with Christ or His Church. Does it break our hearts to know most of those living around us do not know Christ? As we enter 2020, God has given us a new initiative called **ENGAGE 10/10** to guide our work as we seek to give internationals and neighbors the opportunity to hear, understand, and accept the Gospel of Christ in their personal life.

**ENGAGE 10/10** is a call for all Knox County Baptists to network together to engage 10 priority International People Groups and 10 priority Pockets of Lostness. A Pocket of Lostness is defined as an area underserved with a Gospel-centered outreach. **ENGAGE 10/10** challenges us to be more focused in encountering and engaging lostness here in Knox County.

What would happen if several churches network together to become the missionary team for a focus group while fully trusting and expecting God to do a mighty work among them? Our Director of Missions, Phil Young, states: *Perhaps no other group in Knox County is better poised and equipped to engage our communities with the Gospel than the KCAB network of churches. Engaging with the Gospel is what sets us apart from so many other organizations attempting to make a difference in our society. It's about living out and speaking the Gospel of Grace into a diverse culture.*

Join us in praying as our team works to pull together the final list of focus groups and details for bringing our network together in this challenge from God to **ENGAGE 10/10: reaching the nations and our neighbors**. Ask for wisdom and discernment for the team. Begin praying for God to work in the hearts of your church members as to what role your church will take to be missionaries here as we **ENGAGE 10/10** in Knox County.
