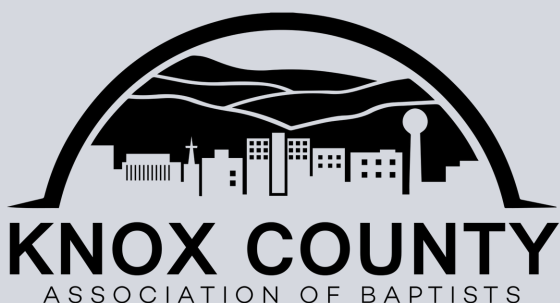

ex·plore: *ex plōr / ik'splôr (verb): travel in or through a new territory or area in order to learn about or familiarize oneself with it*



In his recent book titled *Reviving Evangelism*, George Barna writes: *Sharing one's faith—evangelizing—is a core practice among many religions. For Christians, it's viewed as a mandate from Jesus himself before he departed earth: commanding his disciples to "spread the good news." Yet, today, a number of factors are curbing many Christians' enthusiasm for faith-sharing, including the decline of religion in America, a spreading apathy toward spiritual matters and a growing cultural suspicion of people of faith.*

These factors in our culture are moving the church to take on a missionary posture.

Lance Ford and Brad Briscoe address these challenges in their book, *The Missional Quest*. They write, *A genuine missional movement is not about tweaking the way we do church. Instead, it is a complete and thorough recalibration of the way we understand God's mission in the world and how we are to participate in it.*

Addressing challenges like this will require us to be intentional in our strategy as a network of churches. Our strategy to assist churches toward a missionary approach can be reproduced in every church that desires to be intentional in living out God's mission.

Ford and Briscoe go on to state: *The church must recapture its missionary identity and activate every Jesus-follower to engage wholeheartedly in the ongoing mission of God.* As I have shared with you before, that's what **Ekklesia-Missio Dei** is all about.

In the previous issue of *The Reminder*, I shared with you our desire is to be empowered by His Spirit as we pray for spiritual awakening in our County, in our churches, and in our individual lives. As we move forward in a missionary approach, it is important to explore the community around us. Following proven missionary principles, mapping the geographical, social, and spiritual layers of our communities will help us become familiar with the people we are trying to reach.

We have some of the latest and best resources to help you lead your church to explore the community around you. I am praying for you and your church. Let me know how I can walk alongside you in living out this strategy in your church.

It's time for us to know His mission, be His church, and Live it Out!
